Policy for the priority admission of children of the founding members

The founders of The Island Free School who have been granted this provision are those individuals who played a major role in establishing the school, undertaking activities during the application and pre-opening stages, and have continued to play a significant role in the running of the school – or will do so – since opening. A list of relevant founders who have applied for, and been given, priority admission will be available from the school on request.

What constitutes a major role

- A major role in establishing the school includes writing and contributing to sections of the bid and/or representing the school during the interview process.
- Leading and attending a range of marketing and parent recruitment activities.
- Belonging to and working on one of the pre-opening working parties.
- Becoming a governor in the transition phase to opening.
