



# UNIFORM GUIDE

## INTRODUCTION

Our uniform at The Island Free School is both smart and practical and our pupils feel a sense of pride and community when wearing it.

#### The school crest

Our unique island has a history of beacons and lighthouses, standing confidently and proudly on our landscape, giving safe passage. The beacon on our crest symbolises the guidance and support our school offers to all our pupils.

Similarly, the three anchors illuminated in the lighthouse beams appear on the Isle Of Wight official coat of arms and emphasise we are part of the island community as a whole. The anchors represent the characteristics of resilience, confidence and motivation which are at the heart of our ethos.

#### The Uniform

Whilst we are proud of our crest we minimise the use on all but essential items in order to save parents/carers the cost of branded items and allow for purchase from a range of suppliers.

We run a swap shop where parents can exchange items and for parents and carers whose children are just joining us, uniform can be purchased at discounted rates. Please contact us or view our media posts for opening times.

Pupils enter our school in year 7 as children and leave us at the end of year 11 as young adults.
Our uniform reflects this change.

We differentiate between Key Stage 3 and 4 with the uniform becoming more formal with the introduction of blazers in Key Stage 4.

We believe it is important to be consistent and if parents are at all unsure about the purchase of any uniform items, we encourage you to contact us.

All branded items can be purchased from our uniform supplier. This booklet will guide you on branded and unbranded items and provide information on the expectations for all pupils.
